**RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS SETTING THE TIME AND PLACE FOR CONDUCTING BUSINESS OF STANDING BOARD COMMITTEES**

WHEREAS, the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors Rules of Procedure provides for the appointment of standing committees; and

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 54954(a) requires that standing committees shall provide, by ordinance, resolution, bylaws, or by whatever other rule is required for the conduct of business by that body, the time and place of holding regular meetings; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors that General Government Board Standing Committee will meet and convene as necessary; and further, will be scheduled sequentially dependent upon the number of committees scheduled to meet, unless otherwise indicated following mandated noticing requirements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors that said meetings will be held at the County Administrative Center at 501 Low Gap Road, Ukiah CA, unless otherwise indicated following mandated noticing requirements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors that the Board of Supervisors may cancel Board Standing Committee meetings at such time that no active Committee referrals exist necessitating Committee review.
