

2026 Updated Inventory of Structures - Mendocino Historic Preservation District, Zone A

Background

This report completes **The Inventory of Historic Structures**, last published on June 10, 1992, as Appendix 1, Chapter 4.13 of the Mendocino Town Plan in the County of Mendocino's Coastal Element.

The inventory includes both historic and non-historic buildings found within Zone A of the Mendocino Historic Preservation District. This area is bounded on the west by the Pacific Ocean, on the east by Highway 1, on the north by Slaughterhouse Gulch, and on the south by Big River and Mendocino Bay, excluding the Point of View Estates subdivision (see map in the Mendocino Town Plan). It does not address structures in Zone B, located east of Highway 1.

This list aims to include all standing structures—residential and commercial, barns and sheds, garages, and all water towers—as well as the community gathering spot, park, historic pond, and two cemeteries that were included in the previous version. It does not include empty sites where buildings historically stood.

Information for the inventory was gathered and organized by Karen McGrath, a former director and curator at the Kelley House Museum, city planner, and published author; and Carol Dominy, a past Museum board member, computer engineer, and author of newspaper and social media posts on coastal history. Materials that were used include those originally provided to the County by Mendocino Historical Research, Inc. (Kelley House Museum) and by historian Eleanor Sverko, along with new sources.

A DIGITAL MAP of the Mendocino Historic Preservation District, Zone A, accompanies this inventory. Selecting a building's map symbol produces a pop-up table containing the same information found in this inventory.

Description of Table Data

STRUCTURE ID NUMBER. A unique identification code composed of the last five digits of the assessor's parcel number (APN) plus a letter that provides more information about the structure. For example, the Kelley House, which is the main building on parcel 119-238-17, has been assigned ID Number 238-17-A. Other buildings on that parcel include the Vault Shed (238-17-B), the octagonal shed known as The Loo (238-17-C), and the Bush Shed (238-17-D). The Kelley Water Tower is located on an adjacent parcel to the east, so its ID is 238-16-W. The code is useful for seeing relationships in space and time for all structures built on a particular parcel; since they share the first five numbers of the code, they appear together when the list is sorted on the code.

Letter codes for the Structure ID Numbers are: **A** = Main Building; **B** = Secondary Building; **C** = Tertiary Building, etc. **PD** = Pond; **W** = Water Tower; **WM** = Windmill Tower; **WR** = Water Tower Remnant; **WB** = Water Tower Building (never had a water tank)

NAME of STRUCTURE. The historical building name brought over from the older list, or a more recently assigned name to help distinguish buildings.

NOTES. Additional information, such as position on the lot, the street corner it occupies, the builder's name, previous buildings on the same site, or other useful facts.

STREET NUMBER, STREET NAME & APN. These location identifiers have been obtained from ENPLAN's *Parcel Viewer*, a subscription web map service that sources parcel boundaries from Mendocino County, and property and title details from Data Tree/First American.

EARLIEST DOCUMENTED YEAR. This is the earliest verified year in which a building is known to have existed. When the exact construction date is not known, other evidence is used, such as historic photographs, maps, or references in newspaper articles. If the year is underlined, this confirms that this is the actual year that the building's construction was completed.

CATEGORY. The earlier inventory assigned each structure to a historic category, numbered I, II, III, or IV. The categories included two basic elements: (1) construction date, and (2) degree of architectural alterations in character, architecture modified, or architecture ostensibly altered, but basic structure is discernable. This completed list is intended to satisfy the first element - the construction date - for each building in town.

Buildings from the old list have retained their same category in this updated table. However historic buildings that have been added to this inventory have no category designation; instead, they are labeled **TBD** (to be determined). Non-historic structures built in 1930 or later are also un-categorized and their Category column remains blank. Some structures built before 1929 but potentially misclassified under categories other than historic Category I, II, or III in the old inventory are indicated with an ***ASTERISK**. Likewise, buildings erected after 1929 (non-historic), but previously thought to be in historic Category I, II, or III are also marked with an asterisk.

OLD MAP NO. This references the earlier published inventory, which was sorted by this number. It was associated with a printed map from the 1970s that is no longer used. This number might be useful when comparing the old and the new inventories.

Description of Table Data - continued

CITATION. These are the abbreviated entries for the source materials that document the Earliest Documented Year (previously described) and are more fully explained in the **Citation Bibliography**, below. These sources include local newspapers (1860s to present), photographs (1860s to present), Sanborn Fire Insurance Maps (1883 to 1929), aerial photos (1936 to present), various County building databases (1951 to present), coastal surveys, and other historical materials. Most of these sources can be found online, while the rest can be accessed by contacting curator@kelleyhousemuseum.com.
