**RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ADOPTING THE RULES OF ORDER AND PROCEDURE**

WHEREAS, the rules and procedures of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Mendocino were adopted April 29, 1975, and revised on December 23, 1986; March 4, 1990; March 12, 1991; November 24, 1992; November 5, 1996; January 4, 2000; February 6, 2001; January 8, 2002; January 28, 2003; January 6, 2004; January 25, 2005; February 14, 2006; January 9, 2007; January 8, 2008; January 6, 2009; January 5, 2010; January 4, 2011; January 8, 2013; January 6, 2015; January 5, 2016; January 10, 2017; January 2, 2018, January 8, 2019, and January 7, 2020, January 5, 2021, January 4, 2022, July 12, 2022; January 10, 2023; January 9, 2024; and January 7, 2025.
