RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE CALIFORNIA STATE DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES RECYCLING AND RECOVERY LOCAL ENFORCEMENT AGENCY FOR THE (LEA) PROGRAM FOR FY 26/27 THROUGH FY 31/32 AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF HEALTH SERVICES OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ANNUAL GRANT AGREEMENTS

WHEREAS, on May 5, 2026 the Board of Supervisors of Mendocino County authorized submittal of the application for and acceptance of funds from the California State Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Board acknowledges the benefits and responsibilities to be shared by both parties to said Grant Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the solid waste services will benefit the County and its residents with facility inspections and enforcement; and

WHEREAS, funds are allocated and available from the California State Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery for solid waste facility inspection and enforcement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors approves the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) Grant Program and hereby authorizes the director of health services or designee to sign and execute grant agreement and when available any amendments or renewals there too that do not increase the annual maximum amount of or her three-years.
