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

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER A RESOLUTION OF THE CEMETERY DISTRICT OF THE REDWOODS INCREASING THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FROM THREE (3) MEMBERS TO FIVE (5) MEMBERS AND TO CONSIDER THE ADOPTION OF A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE CEMETERY DISTRICT OF THE REDWOODS FROM THREE (3) MEMBERS TO FIVE (5) MEMBERS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors, at their regular meeting to be held on February 3, 2026, at 9:00am or as soon thereafter as the item may be considered, will conduct a public hearing for the Board of Supervisors to consider a resolution of the Cemetery District of the Redwoods increasing the number of members of the board of trustees from three (3) members to five (5) members, and to consider whether to adopt a resolution of the Board of Supervisors to increase the number of members of the board of trustees for the Cemetery District of the Redwoods from three (3) members to five (5) members, at the time listed or as soon thereafter as the item may be heard. This meeting will take place in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, 501 Low Gap Road, Ukiah California, and virtual attendance will be available via Zoom. At its hearing, the Board of Supervisors will receive and consider any written or oral comments regarding the resolution.
